



OPP SCHOLARSHIP GUIDANCE DOCUMENT

Notre Dame Preschool + PreK is an Ohio Preschool Program (OPP) grant provider. We are provided a limited number of spots from the state of Ohio for this scholarship each year. **Please note that this scholarship differs from the ED Choice scholarship, which does not apply to Preschool + PreK age students.** If interested in receiving this income based scholarship, families must submit an online application to Ohio Benefits to determine eligibility.

To submit an application:

- Gather eligibility documents
 - Proof of US Citizenship or qualified non-citizen for the child
 - Proof of Income or any other money coming into the household (such as pay statements, tax records, award letters, child support)
 - Proof of any Child Support paid for children not living with the applicant
 - Categorical Eligibility, if not income:
 - a) IEP signature page
 - b) Active Case Plan, Family Service Plan or receiving Kinship Permanency Incentive (KPI)
 - c) Zero Income Statement
- Go to the Ohio Benefits Self Service Portal (SSP)

- Click "Apply For Benefits"
- Follow the prompts to apply for OPP benefits (we are NOT a PFCC provider)
- Select site location **Notre Dame Preschool**, license # **1000017748**

Students must be 3 or 4 years of age by Oct. 1st of the current school year *and* meet income guidelines to qualify (**PLEASE SEE CHART ON BACK PAGE OF THIS DOCUMENT FOR INCOME GUIDELINES**). Submitting an application does not guarantee enrollment. This application is to determine **ELIGIBILITY ONLY**. Enrollment is determined by Notre Dame Preschool + PreK staff. Please see the chart for income eligibility. Income must be below the 200% level to qualify.
